

TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

These Temporary Local Rules:

- are to be read in conjunction with the Permanent Local Rules and Rules of Golf.
- supersede all previous versions.

1. 5th hole teeing area, GUR (Garden Bed / Path) and Dropping Zone

White stakes define a single relief area that includes the GUR (garden bed) and the adjacent cart path. The ground to the right of the cart path is no longer GUR (ball must be played as lies or take unplayable ball relief). A new 'GUR' Dropping Zone has been created to the right of the cart path. For ANY ball at rest in this single relief area, the player may take normal Rule 16.1 relief **OR** use the optional Dropping Zone.

NOTE: The Dropping Zone further forward near the red tee is NOT available for free relief from the GUR. Taking GUR relief from the forward relief area will incur the general penalty.

2. Unusual damage and Storm Remediation on holes 2, 3, 5 and 6 only.

If a player's ball is deemed to be at rest in the General Area* and there is interference (stance or swing) from:

- a. stump holes (does NOT include stumps),
- b. machinery damage from ongoing clean-up remediation works.

Relief may be taken – in consultation with your marker.

Relief may taken within one club length of nearest point of full relief, no nearer the hole.

*the 'general area' covers the entire course except for teeing area, bunkers, penalty areas and putting greens.
