CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. 18 Hole stroke event open to all men and women with a Golf Australia handicap.
2. Entries must be made on-line via Murrumbidgee Country Club web site at www.murrumbidgeegolf.com.au Entry fee of \$40.
3. Entries close Sunday 23 August 2026, or when the field capacity is reached. Late entries may be accepted, subject to vacancies in the field.
4. The draw will be issued on 25 August 2026.
5. The Murrumbidgee Country Club Match Committee will make all arrangements and shall have full power to alter or make any variations to these conditions.
6. All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Match Committee, which reserves the right to refuse any entry.
7. The Rules of Golf and the local rules of Murrumbidgee Country Club will be the rules of play during the Event.
8. Starting Times: Players shall start at the time reserved for them on the on-line booking sheet. All players must be ready to tee-off 15 minutes prior to their allocated time slot. The Match Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter starting times.
9. The Murrumbidgee Match Committee, whose decision is final, will settle all disputes. Any member of the Match Committee involved in a dispute will not be eligible to render any ruling on that dispute.
10. All competitors are required to abide by the dress requirements of Murrumbidgee Country Club. Metal spikes are not permitted.
11. Caddies are permitted. Motorised transport may be used by players providing that the course superintendent determines that course conditions are suitable for carts on the day of play
12. Carts will be booked with the Pro-shop
13. Non-members wanting to use their own carts MUST obtain permission from the General Manager.
14. In the event that carts are not permitted on the course on the day of play, participants who require a cart for medical reasons may obtain a refund of their entry by submitting a written request to the club and including a copy of a current medical certificate
15. Mobile phones may be carried but must be in silent mode at all times. A player may use mobile phones for distance measuring, scoring or any other purpose but its use must not interfere with or disrupt another player
16. There will be separate competitions for men and women.
17. All play will be from the green tees and commence from the 1st tee.
18. Handicap divisions, if any, will be determined according to the number of entries.
19. The championship will be awarded to the man and woman with the best gross score over the 18 holes.
20. Prizes will also be awarded for the best nett scores
21. A junior (18 years or younger) prize will awarded if more than five eligible entries are received.
22. Ties will be determined by a count back as described by Golf Australia.
23. Only one 18 hole prize will be awarded to any one player.
